

ST JOSEPH'S SALE SVP PARISH REPORT 1 APRIL 2022- 31 MARCH 2023

Our Parish SVP group of 14 active & 15 auxiliary members is part of the Society of St Vincent de Paul, an international charity which supports people in need. St Joseph's has had an SVP group since 1914. In the year 2022-23 we undertook the following activities:

- Conference members made 630 visits to people in their own homes and 26 visits to care homes, providing support to 38 people in their own homes & 40 people in care homes
- Provided transport on 57 occasions and practical support (including shopping) on 42 occasions
- Organised a Summer tea party & Christmas lunch attended by over 70 people
- Organised a mass for healing attended by 20 people
- Went carol singing to 2 local care homes
- Organised a day trip to Blackpool for 2 people with serious health problems
- Transported an ethnic minority asylum family to the SVP caravan in Wales and brought them back
- Worked with local schools & the children's liturgy group to create & hand deliver
 Christmas Hampers & Easter Cards to 36 people & 6 care homes
- Paid a film club subscription for one of our care homes
- Gave practical assistance to several beneficiaries by purchasing the following items for a variety of beneficiaries: telephone, fan, mini fridge and freezer.
- 11 Members of the conference helped support a 34 mile sponsored walk "The Sandstone Trail" which raised money for the SVP Community Project in Birkenhead
- Arranged a house deep cleaning for a 1 terminally ill beneficiary and undertook carpet cleaning for another.
- Our Treasurer has regularly attended Churches Together in Sale meetings and reported back to the conference.
- Our Youth Officer co-ordinated a visit from the National Office Director of Youth and the Head of Youth and Mini Vinnies to 2 local schools to see good practice.
 She also visited 5 schools to support their youth SVP groups
- We have recruited 4 full and 1 auxiliary new members through a parish recruitment drive
- In total over 2000 hours were spent by our volunteers on SVP activities
